The school's mission is **"to educate children who have communication delays and learning differences empowering them with the tools to succeed."** It is located on a Texas Hill Country summer camp style 17-acre campus in West Houston.

Founded in 1983 by Houston native, Robbin Parish M.A. CCC-SLP, her vision was to focus on early intervention for children to develop communication skills, academic preparedness, resilience, self-advocacy, social competence and self-confidence. Her vision is shared by an affiliate, The Carruth Center, a private, non-profit clinic in Houston, which is located on the campus.
